

Instructions for the Choice of GE/VAC/SEC Courses for Academic session 2025-26

All GE/SEC/VAC will be opted by all students of Academic year (2025-26) as per their framework through the following link:

1. Generic Elective (GE) Course:

- a. Students enrolled in **B.A.(Hons.)/ B.Sc.(Hons.)** will have to opt for one GE course from a pool of GE courses offered by the college. **Students cannot opt for the GE paper from the same discipline/ department.** For example, a student of B.Sc(Hons) Chemistry cannot opt for GE paper offered by the Chemistry department.
- b. For **B.A. (Prog)/B.Com. (Prog)**: A student enrolled in **B.A. (Prog.)/ B.Com (Prog.)** will study **English/Hindi/Sanskrit** in Ist and IIIrd SEM. Students can opt GE from pool of GE courses offered by the college in Vth and VIIth SEM.
- c. For B.Sc.(Physical Sciences: Chemistry/Computer Science): Multidisciplinary
(i) A student enrolled in **B.Sc.(Physical Sciences with Chemistry)** can opt for GE except Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. (ii) A student enrolled in **B.Sc.(Physical Science with Computer Sc)** can opt for GE except Physics, Mathematics and Computer Sc.

2. Skill Enhancement Course(SEC):

Students of all courses will opt any one SEC course from the pool of SEC courses offered by the College (**see Table-2**). Detailed description of SEC course are available on the college website. No student is allowed to repeat any SEC paper earlier studied.

3. Value Addition Course (VAC):

Students of all courses will opt one VAC course from the pool of VAC offered by the College (**see Table-3**). Detailed description of VAC course are available on the college website. No student is allowed to repeat any VAC paper earlier studied.

NOTE:

- Seats are on the basis of first come and first serve.
- **Fill 3 preferences for each paper.**
- Paper option will be restricted once the capacity of one section is achieved for a particular paper.
- Students have to adhere to the option submitted and the examination form is to be filled according to the seats allocated.
- The listed SEC/VAC/GE will be offered subject to minimum number of students applying for the paper.
- Discrepancy, if any in the GE/SEC/VAC as mentioned above, may kindly be brought to the notice of the respective nodal officers, College office and academic committee convenor for the necessary modification.
- No change shall be entertained after the submission of form.
